KEY CONSIDERATIONS

Please note: The Hot Wash Station relies on a gas cylinder which is not supplied by Garic and needs to be sourced separately.

Gas bottle replacement should be carried out by a competent person. Ensure proper connection to mains or waste tank. Dispose of soil from the boot wash tray responsibly. Equipment should be commissioned on a level surface. Empty the water from the boot wash tray when not in use.
